



PROJECT PROFILE

BASINVIEW ANIMAL HOSPITAL

When asked to provide input into the profile selection for roof and cladding, material of the new Basinview Animal Hospital the decision was simple. For the roofing cladding Agway recommended its Nail Strip (NS) 38 with a 24 Gauge. After assessing the overall look of the project, it was recommended that a Jet Black colour would work very nicely. The Nail Strip profile provided both the appeal and durability required from the roofing.

For the primary wall configuration the selection of Agway's 7/8" Corrugated delivered the more contemporary look desired for the project. The colour recommended consisted of bone white and jet black. This would complement the roofing cladding as well as achieve the desired aesthetics for the project's overall appearance.

To complement the overall appearance Agway's Stratus Profile was used for the entrance and canopy. The use of black, maintaining consistency with the overall project, as well as a blend of Roasted Ash to accentuate the black colour became a very important highlight.

As a finishing touch to the project Stratus Perforated Soffits in the Roasted Ash colour were used to maintain consistency with the selection of profiles and colours.
