Metallic Polyesters are the most cost effective metallic paint system available and are typically used for interior applications.

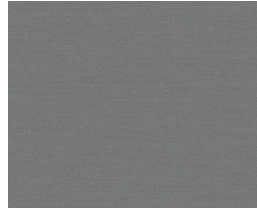
Metallic PVDFs are a high end paint system ideal for use in roofing and cladding applications.
